"On nice days when I want to take a walk from the kitchen at South Gate, I head down to [Margon](#) (136 W 46th St between Sixth and Seventh Aves; 212-354-5013). It's a sliver of a Cuban diner that has great, super-cheap food. The *Cubano* sandwiches are pretty massive, and they're about 6 bucks. You line up in the front for those and you can also head to the back counter for more plated dishes. I take my Cubano and walk back uptown and enjoy it in Central Park, though it smells so good that it's hard not to nosh on it during the walk."
